Well... let's look at the timeline.

- On Saturday, January 28, the balloon was first detected in U.S. airspace near Alaska. And despite apparently already knowing about the Chinese intelligence program, we decide that it poses no threat. Ok. Weird... but ok. Let's move on.
- By Monday Jan 30th, NORAD picks up the trail as the balloon prances into Canadian airspace. An adversarial surveillance tool was hovering over our Northern neighbor, and there was ZERO response from the military. There was ZERO communication from the government.
- On Tuesday January 31st, the balloon moved to Northern Idaho. THIS time, it was no longer in our backyard, it was IN our yard. And still... crickets from the government.
- By Wednesday, the balloon had made its way to Montana. Flight traffic at Billings Logan International Airport was grounded for two hours, but WE STILL didn't have any official explanation or statement for what was going on.

- Meanwhile, as reported by Politico, Secretary of State Blinken was quietly meeting with officials at the Chinese Embassy. Keep that in mind, because we're going to come back to it in a second.

 - This video was uploaded to Twitter by Chase Doak on Thursday. Images of the balloon started blowing up social media. It was only THEN that the Pentagon finally issued a statement verifying what was going on.
 - It almost seems like the government was content to let this balloon casually strafe sensitive military installations, without telling us, BEFORE it was blasted all over social media. Did a single photographer in Montana force the government's hand?
 - Later that day, Secretary Blinken announced he was postponing his upcoming trip to China, and it kind of makes me wonder... Was that trip the reason for all the secrecy? Was that why we hesitated on acting when it was near Alaska?
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Why didn't we shoot down the balloon sooner?

- This is a predicted flight path of the balloon. They could have shot it down in the waters West of Alaska. THEY DIDN'T. Instead, they let it travel into Alaska, down Canada, then all the way across the Continental United States.

- “I’m not going to categorize them as balloons. We’re calling them objects for a reason. I’m not able to categorize how they stay aloft. It could be a gaseous type of balloon inside a structure or it could be some type of a propulsion system. But clearly, they’re—they’re able to stay aloft.”

- Does this not sound like something describing the Cold War with the Soviet Union?
- This all sounds very similar to a book written by two members of the Chinese Communist military back in 1999. It was called *Unrestricted Warfare*, and it was written in the aftermath of the first Gulf War.

 - The speed, lethality and precision of Desert Storm scared the crap out of our adversaries. Especially... the Chinese. They knew they could never defeat the United States in a conventional war. Instead, and until they could catch up

militarily, they hypothesized using globalization as a tool to fight the United States.

- The authors called it “non-military war.” And they actually listed out several ways of fighting. Directly from the book:
 - Psychological warfare
 - Smuggling warfare/Economic
 - Media warfare
 - Drug warfare
 - Network warfare/espionage
 - Technological warfare/creating monopolies
 - Resources warfare/plundering the world’s resources
 - Cultural warfare
 - International law warfare
 - These were but SOME of the ways China assessed we were vulnerable. They said these have “the same and even greater destructive force than military warfare.”
 - What they are describing is a quiet war, fought by unconventional methods, which has been going on for DECADES.
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China’s “Unrestricted Warfare:” Propaganda

- There’s probably not a movie out right now that Hollywood hasn’t tweaked after bowing to their Chinese masters. Movies like *Iron Man 3*, *World War Z*, *Bohemian Rhapsody*, *Star Trek*, *Alien*, *Skyfall*, *Doctor Strange*... ALL were changed to appease China.

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China’s “Unrestricted Warfare:” Intellectual Property

- Everything else we saw regarding China’s abuse of intellectual property rights and unfair trade practices (largely brought to light during the Trump Administration), is ALL a part of this “UNRESTRICTED” war. They use international trade laws to keep the operation active.

- The most recent example was when China took their case to the WTO to halt Biden's export ban of semi-conductors. International trade law was one of the biggest areas of vulnerability that China mentioned in *Unrestricted Warfare*, and they've been gaming it for decades.

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China's "Unrestricted Warfare:" Cyber Attacks

- China's cyber onslaught has been absolutely INSANE. We're not talking about ransomware attacks or things like that. When they decide to send a cyber attack... they go for the jugular.
 - In 2004, a single Chinese cyber-espionage ring hacked U.S. military labs, NASA and the World Bank.
 - In 2006, they hacked the U.S. State Department.
 - They hacked the Commerce Department, the Naval War College, U.S. Senators, the Commerce Secretary, and even Lockheed Martin's F-35 program.
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China's "Unrestricted Warfare:" Espionage

- A few months ago the non-profit human rights group Safeguard Defenders exposed 110 Chinese police stations all over the world. FOUR were in the United States.
- Chinese agents operated out of these stations to spy on dissidents and threaten their families if they didn't return to China.

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China's "Unrestricted Warfare:" Natural Resources

- The authors of *Unrestricted Warfare* listed "Resource Warfare" as one of their top strategies. They described it as "grabbing riches by plundering stores of resources."
